4. The FTSE 100 Index was 7687 on December 31st 2017 and 6728 on December 31st 2018. What will be the index on 31st December 2019? (1 point within 100, 2 pts within 50, 3pts within 10)

5. Base Rate started 2018 at 0.5% and was raised to 0.75% on 2nd August 2018. What will be Base Rate on December 31st 2019? (A multiple of .25%)

6. The Sterling/Euro exchange rate started 2018 at 1.13 and ended at 1.11. How will it end in 2019?

7. The Sterling/Dollar exchange rate started 2018 at 1.36 and ended at 1.26. How will it end in 2019?

Sport

8. In recent years, the top teams in the UK Premier League have been Arsenal, Chelsea, Liverpool, Manchester City, Manchester United and Tottenham. Who will be heading the table on 31st December 2019? (2 points for the top and one point for second)

9. The Men's Wimbledon final in 2018 was between Novak Djokovic who defeated Kevin Anderson. Name one of the two finalists in 2019. 1 point if it is Djokovic, 2 points for anyone else

10 The Derby is run in Surrey in early June, this year with 23 entrants. You are asked to predict the race card number of the winner (1-23). Some entries drop out at various stages and there are seldom more than 15 who actually start

11 BBC Sports Personality of the Year is awarded in December. In 2018 it was won by cyclist Geraint Thomas who won the Tour de France. What sport will win in 2019? (Extra point for right name as well)

12 Who is going to win the Rugby World Cup, being held this Autumn in Japan. 1 point if it is New Zealand, 2 points for anyone else

13 Surrey won the County Cricket Championship in 2018. Who will win in 2019? Competing teams are Surrey, Somerset, Essex, Yorkshire, Nottinghamshire, Warwickshire and Kent (in 2018 finishing order)
